The Sime Brothers were 2 of a family of 10 children who lived next door at number 40 Dalmeny Street. Robert aged 21 was a postman and James, aged 23, was an iron-moulder and a Lance Corporal in the Battalion. Both brothers lost their lives in the crash.

Research volunteer Tom Bolland chose the Sime brothers who lived next door to the Drill Hall because he used to live in this area when he was younger and Dalmeny Street was on his milk round.
